The Port of Vancouver

- Trade Volume: Handled a record 158 million metric tonnes of cargo in 2024
- Container Throughput: 3.47 million TEU's in 2024
- Cargo Diversity: Bulk, breakbulk, liquid bulk, and containerized cargo
- Trade Value: Facilitates approximately \$300 billion in trade annually, accounting for onethird of Canada's trade in goods outside North America
- Employment Impact: Supports over 132,400 jobs across Canada, contributing \$16.3 billion to the national GDP
- Operational Risks: Labour disputes
- Infrastructure Improvements: Ongoing enhancements

- Hold quarterly meetings where they discuss claim trends, recent events and problematic issues being faced by the industry




